## Planning for Educating Beyond the Classroom, Substitution, and Quarantines

#### **EARLY CHILDHOOD**

The Early Childhood campus can have as many as 2 lead teachers absent IF at least one experienced substitute can step in. If that is not the case, the EC branch may need to close. You will be notified via text and email as soon as possible.

#### **LOWER SCHOOL**

If a student needs to quarantine for 10-14 days, the teacher will provide distance learning. Additionally, the parent can request live streaming from school so that the student can view and participate in classes. A teacher may also require live streaming of an upper grade student. Other accommodations will be made as needed.

# If a lower school teacher has to quarantine:

**Grades 1-3 and 5-7:** Students will still come to school and the teacher will teach remotely into the classroom. Another teacher will be on standby to assist the class and support if there are technical difficulties. The quarantined teacher may also use Google classroom to deliver notes, assignments etc., depending on the grade.

**Grade 4:** The teacher will provide quality Waldorf lessons remotely.

If a teacher is unwell and unable to teach in-person or remotely, substitute teaching will be arranged.

If a teacher is unable to teach remotely and substitution cannot be secured, the cohort will be combined and the students will work together during the Main Lesson on a common project, planned ahead of time for such a situation.

If more than two teachers are unable to teach in-person, the entire LS branch will move to remote learning from home. There may be one or two transition days where students will attend school with a modified schedule and prepare to move to remote learning. You will be notified via email and text as soon as possible.

### **HIGH SCHOOL**

If a student needs to quarantine for 10-14 days, the teacher will livestream from school so that the student can view and participate in classes. Other accommodations will be made as needed.

If a high school teacher has to quarantine, students will still come to school and the teacher will teach remotely into the classroom. Another teacher will be on standby to assist the class and support if there are technical difficulties. The quarantined teacher may also use Google classroom to deliver notes, assignments etc.

If a teacher is unwell and unable to teach in person or remotely, substitute teaching will be arranged.

If more than two teachers are unable to teach at school, the entire HS branch will move to remote learning from home. There will be one or two transition days where students will attend school with a modified schedule and prepare to move to remote learning. You will be notified via email and text as soon as possible.
